Intended learning outcomes		
<p>By analysing the diversity of cultures and cultural interpretive patterns, the students gain basic knowledge of scientifically sound approaches to intercultural learning. Practical exercises and role plays enable the students to transfer their knowledge to real situations to strengthen both their ability to critically reflect their own point of view as well as their social and personal competence. The primary goal is to acquire intercultural key competencies.</p>
