Assessment in module component 01-M7-1-092: Gott und Götter: Israels Weg zum Bekenntnis des einen Gottes (God and Gods: Israel's Way Towards Monotheism), **in module component 01-M9-1-092:** Christliche Lebensführung (Taufe, Eucharistie, Buße) in der frühen Kirche (Christian Lifestyle (Baptism, Eucharist, Penitence) in the Early Church), **in module component 01-M9-2-092:** Wege christlichen Denkens in Mittelalter und Neuzeit (Ways of Christian Thought in the Middle Ages and Modern Period), **in module component 01-M11-1-092:** Historische Ausprägungen christlicher Spiritualität (Historical Forms of Christian Spirituality)

- 1.25 ECTS credits, numerical grading
- a) oral examination of one candidate each (approx. 15 minutes) or b) oral examination in groups (groups of 2: approx. 30 minutes, groups of 3: approx. 45 minutes) or c) talk (approx. 15 minutes) with written elaboration or d) written examination (approx. 30 minutes) or e) term paper (approx. 5 pages) or f) assessments during lecture period (approx. 3 to 5 assessments, 15 hours total, e. g. project or portfolio) Assessments that use one of the methods d) through f) may be administered electronically, i. e. may be computerised.
- Additional prerequisites: Ancient Greek and Latin language skills (01-M7-1-092: Ancient Greek, Latin and Hebrew language skills)
