This module equips students with the basic biblical (Koine) Greek language skills that are, pursuant to Section 79 LPO I (examination regulations for teaching degree programmes dated 13 March 2008), a prerequisite for admission to the state examination in Catholic religious education.

At the end of the course, students will have developed a basic knowledge of the Greek language as well as basic skills in the translation of biblical texts. They will be able to read and interpret texts written in biblical Greek.
