<p>Two placements (to be completed in the area of mandatory electives and worth 5 ECTS credits each) to provide students with insights into potential areas of employment for theologians. Placements may be in the following areas: community, school and education, caritas and social services, science and administration as well as media and the private sector. Students will be expected to critically and constructively reflect upon their placements in reports and attend wrap-up discussion sessions. Their reports will serve as the basis for these discussions. The course will be graded on the basis of the reports written by students. Grades will be awarded by the Chair of Pastoral Theology.</p>		
<b>Intended learning outcomes</b>		
<p>At the end of the course, students will have gained insights into two potential areas of employment for theologians (community, school and education, caritas and social services, science and administration, media and the private sector) and will have gained experience that will be useful in their future careers. They will be able to critically reflect upon the personal, theological, and methodological skills they have developed as well as upon the areas of employment.</p>
