It helps them prepare for their mandatory placements, provides competent support during those placements, and gives them the opportunity to reflect upon the placements in wrap-up discussion sessions. Placements will have a duration of four to six weeks, and students will be expected to write a report on each placement. Those reports will serve as the basis for the wrap-up discussions. The aim of the module is to provide students with first-hand insights into different fields of pastoral activity and give them the opportunity to engage in theory-based critical reflection on the experiences they have made.

Intended learning outcomes

To pass this module, students will be expected to be able to draw upon the knowledge they have gained throughout the programme, identify the challenges and opportunities presented by particular situations, propose appropriate measures, put them into practice (under expert guidance) as well as to justify and reflect upon the associated processes.
