<b>Contents</b>		
Discussing examples from the sacramental (baptism, penance, eucharist) and personal (sexuality) lives of individuals, this module investigates, and reflects upon, different ways of Christian thought and ethics. In this context, it also explores some of the main controversies in theology.		
<b>Intended learning outcomes</b>		
At the end of the course, students will have gained an insight into the development of ecclesial theology and practice. They will be able to look at life and its relationship to the sacraments of baptism, penance, and eucharist from new perspectives.
