This module equips students with an advanced knowledge of the regional history of Franconia and Bavaria. It provides an overview of Franconian and Bavarian history and discusses selected examples. The courses focus on discussing methods in history that are employed in Germany. A particular focus is on digital research in regional history (databases, editions, digital cartography, simulations).

Students are able to familiarise themselves with more complex issues, employing the methods of the discipline and taking into account relevant source material and secondary literature as well as the findings of related disciplines. They are able to independently analyse and interpret sources and accounts of regional history. They are able to record, interpret, and present their findings, using modern software.
