<b>Intended learning outcomes</b>		
<p>Students consolidate their knowledge and qualifications on the basis of current research publications or individually formulated research questions concerning a sub-discipline didactics in order to expand their relevant subject-didactic competency and contemplation competences regarding a German class of the secondary education I and II. Here, they establish a connection of fundamental theory and practical experiences and possess knowledge of current empirical findings from the teaching/learning research, which they annotate critically and specify on the basis of core themes that are important in class. They independently acquire research literature, which they present in an appropriate way and dialogically interview about possibilities to affiliate the subject teaching.</p>
