The module "Media, Image, Technologies" provides students with specialised knowledge of central technologies and media development (e.g. photography, film, television) and the establishment of medial or technical networks with the help of representative examples from North American history. Dealing with these media cultures includes issues concerning the literary and cultural reflection of transnational exchange processes as well as of processes regarding cultural, political and economic globalisation.

#### **Intended learning outcomes**

After successful completion of the module, students are able to understand and evaluate literature and culture as fields of social and political interaction, to discuss literary and cultural issues from an interdisciplinary perspective, and to analyse and discuss theoretical issues concerning the role of literature and culture with a focus on medial and technological correlations.
