<b>Contents</b>		
The basic module provides students with basic knowledge of literature and cultural history of the US or the British Isles (including new anglophone literatures) as well as literature and cultural science-based theory and methodology. In order to apply these skills, students will practise the analysis and interpretation of selected texts of all literary genres from the early modern era up to the present.		
<b>Intended learning outcomes</b>		
Ability to apply literary and cultural science-based theories and methods to the text analysis. Basic knowledge of historical contexts and developments as well as concerning the intellectual history.
