<p>The module covers central concepts and methods in the field of phonology, morphology, syntax, lexicology, semantics and pragmatics and their application on the French. Central issues and methods of historic linguistics will be covered, too. As well as important structural changes of the French and the Romance Languages in general. Students will learn about the most important linguistic theories. They will acquire central techniques of the academic work (information research as well as preparation and presentation of information) concerning the Romance linguistics. The module covers French literature and cultural history. Introduction to literary genres, literary theory and literature analysis as well as to basics of the academic work.</p>

<p>Students acquire basic skills of French and Romance linguistics. They are able to apply the most important linguistic description terms and methods to the French language. Students are familiar with basic techniques of scientific work in the area of Romance linguistics. Students achieve basic skills of the French literature and cultural history, literature and cultural theory as well as basic skills of text analysis. They are able to apply the theory to specific texts.</p>
