This module discusses horizons of interpretation in the investigation of complex structural and systematic processes, both epochal and cross-epochal, in the sub-disciplines of history. It also explores sources, methods, and theories of history and its sub-disciplines in detail, discussing selected narrowly defined problems in depth.

Students are able to familiarise themselves with more complex issues, employing the methods of the disciplines and taking into account relevant source material and secondary literature as well as the findings of related disciplines. They are able to analyse and interpret sources and accounts relating to the sub-disciplines of history.
