The module provides students with the main issues of the Italian language in the area phonetics, grammar and syntax; existing skills will be consolidated and expanded. Object of the module will be the Italian present-day language (standard language).

Students consolidate the skills of the Italian language that have been acquired during the basic module 1. They acquire the required reading ability and speaking skills for their studies. The students are able to express themselves on an intermediate level (B2) orally, to read literary texts, to analyse linguistic phenomena and to identify and apply grammar structures.
