Intended learning outcomes Students have advanced knowledge of Latin grammar rules, especially syntax; they have advanced knowledge of Latin phraseology; they are able to translate easy and moderately difficult* German texts, which contain ancient thinking and ideas, into appropriate or classical Latin (retroversions). Students have an in-depth ability to develop a limited sub-area of Latin literature with the methodological tools of classics and have extensive experience with various methods of interpretation and their application.
