Contents

The module covers special stylistics of word classes; Latin syntax; broadening of an active basic vocabulary; the translation of simple German texts (art and literary texts) into Latin; the translation of works of a Latin author (poetry or prose) into German; the imparting of basic skills in terms of the historical grammar of the Latin language.

Intended learning outcomes

Students are acquainted with substantial differences in the use of word classes in the German and Latin language; They are able to apply the respective rules of translation to simple German texts (e.g. texts of art and literature) into Latin; They have knowledge of a broadened active basic vocabulary; They are able to translate texts of a Latin author into appropriate German, which meets the respective genre. They have a basic knowledge of historical grammar of the Latin language.
