The confrontation with a number of other native speakers as teachers as well as the linguistic environment in Beijing serves to place linguistic competence in all fields (spoken language, written expression, reading competence) on a broad basis. A systematic repetition of grammatical phenomena is used to deepen the knowledge. All grammar is intensively repeated and specifically completed from the perspective of Chinese linguistics.</p>
