The student recognises the fundamental importance of interdisciplinary approaches for researching the interfaces of music and other media and also has basic knowledge of the media-related state of music in an exemplary subject area. The student is able to discuss media-theoretical methods or individual strategies in terms of their aims and argumentation and to apply them to examples.
