<p>The knowledge of the polyphonic composition acquired in 04-MW-MT-2 will be deepened and placed in a two-part historical perspective; The focus is on the theory and practice of vocal polyphonic composition on the one hand (including composition models, clause theory, key theory) and on the instrumental counterpoint to be derived from this on the other hand (including ornamentation, fugue construction). The focus of the associated exercise is the creative application of the rules gained in the main course to given compositions (reduction, reworking) up to own attempts in historical style.</p>
