Contents					
Presentation of the history of music from the early modern period to the present on the basis of an integrative in- terpretation of cultural history. The focus is on central forms, styles, persons of European music history and the presentation of selected music cultural centres. Epochal terms (Renaissance, Enlightenment, Classicism, Roman- ticism, Modernism, Postmodernism) and concepts or metaphors of historical processes (progress, development, discursive rupture, history of paradigms) are problematised. Using historically significant examples, the interre- lation of a problematic history of composing with music theoretical and music aesthetic reflection and polemics will be shown.					
Intended learning outcomes					
The student is able to deal with central phenomena of music and music history from the early modern period to the present in a reflected manner; He/she has basic knowledge of the historical forms of appearance of European music and an understanding of the music-historical processes. He/she is able to discuss the problems of these in basic terms of cultural history.
