Classical concepts (e.g., Nietzsche, Aurelius) and contemporary topics (e.g., sustainability, mindfulness) are analyzed and reflected upon in terms of their relevance to educational science.</p>

<p>Students engage in-depth with key concepts, theories, and practices of ethics and reflect on their relevance for educational science. They analyze classical and contemporary approaches—such as models of the art of living, sustainability, or mindfulness—with regard to their significance for self-formation and pedagogical action. In doing so, they strengthen their capacity for ethical judgment, critical self-reflection, and independent engagement with the normative dimensions of education.</p>
