The students know possibilities and materials for individualised and differentiated classes. They are able to analyse and organise school and pre-school learning areas. They know organisation forms and pedagogical implications of learning in heterogeneous groups. The students are able to organise work groups. They are able to work in teams, share responsibilities and discuss the presentation of results. The students can present theory-driven contexts of justification. They are able to transfer results of scientific work to school processes, evaluate the use of means in school and create own learning materials.
