It discusses discursive formations and practices in education policy and, on the other hand, explores the possibilities of educating the political in the sense of a practice of freedom.

They can explain how specific forms of subjectivity are inherent in it and what these are. They can also discuss the possibilities for political action, with the aim of criticizing and transforming orders, and situate educational processes within this context.
