The module focuses on adult and continuing education as a didactic field of action. To this end, students deal theoretically with basic terms and concepts of didactics and methods in adult and continuing education. On this basis, they independently select a mentor from the practice of adult and continuing education and analyze the didactic design of an adult education teaching/learning event. The focus of the module is on the reflective integration of theoretical and practical knowledge.

Intended learning outcomes

Students understand adult and continuing education as a didactic field of action. They understand didactics as a multi-level phenomenon, can differentiate between didactic levels of action and apply this knowledge in practice, for example, when selecting mentors for theory-practice reflection. In addition, they understand (adult) learning theories, didactic approaches and principles as well as methods and can understand their connections with didactic decisions. Based on this knowledge, they can analysenalyaze and reflect on didactic action in adult education practice.
