In the seminar, the module expands on selected historical chapters or epochs of pedagogy, their pedagogically significant questions and historically relevant movements, their important representatives and their works. The exercise is dedicated to historical source work and the methodical, reflective examination of material representations of history. Here, primary sources from the educational era focused on in the seminar are used as examples.

Intended learning outcomes

Students can reconstruct and understand the subject matter, methods and characteristics of pedagogical historiography. Students will be able to describe and classify historical stages and epochs as well as their pedagogically relevant questions and assess their history of impact. They will be able to analyze historically relevant pedagogical movements in terms of their theoretical relevance for the present. They understand historical contexts as a lens for reflection that helps to shed light on blind spots in the present and to understand their unquestionability and formability. They will also be able to recognize and interpret historical sources and inquire about their context of origin.
