The module addresses perspectives on being human which are connected to the structure of educational thinking and acting and which have explicitly or implicitly got an impact on the understanding of education. Turning away from anthropological fundamentalism, it deals with the structural conditions and possibilities of being human in specific historical, cultural and biographical forms, such as its temporality, culturality, bodyhood or subjectivity.		
Intended learning outcomes		
The students understand the possibilities of being human within its sociohistorical variabilities. They have got insight into the relation educational concepts and characteristic dimensions of human existence. They have acquired a critically-reflexive awareness of the plural possibilities and limits in order to determine what is specific to human beings, and they are also aware of the often dehumanizing consequences of such determinations.
