Contents		
This module gives a broad insight in the basics of clinical psychology in general as well as specific concepts of psychopathology with a focus on diagnostic and classification, epidemiology, comorbidities and etiology of the most frequent disorders. The lecture introduces concepts of development, maintenance and progression of psychopathologies and methods of research in clinical psychology and experimental psychopathology. Scientifically based interventions will be taught exemplary for important disorders. The seminar will address changing topics of clinical psychology and experimental psychopathology and deepen the understanding of important disorders.		
Intended learning outcomes		
Students will know diagnostic criteria, epidemiology and comorbidities of most psychological disorders. They will acquire competence to judge the scientific quality of clinical psychology studies, and based on this competence they will be able to critically evaluate concepts of development, maintenance and progression of psychopathologies (lecture). The seminar will give them competence to evaluate new developments related to specific psychopathologies and new concepts of clinical psychological research.
