<p>In this module, the students acquire basic knowledge of thinking, feeling and behaviour in a social context. They become acquainted with different subject areas, theories and methods of Social Psychology and with applied questions, e.g. regarding persuasion or prejudices. They discuss empirical findings and interrelate these with theories and everyday phenomena.</p>		
<b>Intended learning outcomes</b>		
<p>The students acquire professional skills and social competencies, which can be useful in everyday situations (e.g. for solving social conflicts and central problems of social influenceability). Additionally, the students become acquainted with the logics of empirical research and its validity for everyday phenomena and are therefore enabled to differentiate between causation and correlation.</p>
