Correct version: This course aims to consolidate the students' theological thinking, expression, and writing skills on the basis of current debates and important texts. [Version 1: Writing a Bachelor's thesis in accordance with the principles of good scholarly practice.] [Version 2: Biblical theology. Grounding in the texts of the Old Testament, their connection, meaning in a historical context, and introduction to the exegetical methods.]		
Intended learning outcomes		
At the end of the course, students will have developed a comprehensive knowledge of systematic theology. They will be able to recognise topics in their complex interrelations with all other topics in theology - in particular theories of religion - and to describe them orally and in writing. Students will have adopted a supra-individual position on all topics based on a sharpened awareness of problems and sound arguments. They will be able to interpret topics in theology within the context of current social problems and discuss potential solutions.
