<p>This course aims to consolidate the students' theological thinking, expression, and writing skills. The contents of all exegetical topics are interrelated and linked. The course explores connections between issues in biblical theology, church history, and dogmatics and the traditions of other religions including, but not limited to, the world religions of Judaism, Islam, and Buddhism.</p>		
<b>Intended learning outcomes</b>		
<p>At the end of the course, students will have developed the knowledge in the exegetical disciplines that is required for teaching religious education. They will be able to recognise topics in their complex interrelations with all other topics in theology - in particular theories of religion - and to describe them orally and in writing. Students will have adopted a supra-individual position on all topics based upon an increased awareness of problems and sound arguments. They will be able to interpret topics in theology within the context of current social problems and discuss potential solutions.</p>
