This course aims to consolidate the students' theological thinking, expression, and writing skills. The contents of all topics in dogmatics and religious education are interrelated and linked.		
<b>Intended learning outcomes</b>		
At the end of the course, students will have developed the knowledge in dogmatics and religious education that is required for teaching religious education. They will be able to recognise topics in their complex interrelations with other topics in theology and to describe them both orally and in writing. Students will have adopted a supra-individual position on all topics based upon an increased awareness of problems and sound arguments. They will be able to interpret topics in theology within the context of current social problems and discuss potential solutions.
