<p>After collecting information on the state of research and theory of a selected topic of pedagogy and/or psychology, the students independently examine this topic on the basis of specific goals and questions and carry out a sub-project with a specific result. This might result in an empirical study, the development of a theory-oriented concept, the development of a pedagogical or therapeutic-pedagogical concept, an exemplary, evaluation-based application in class, the writing of a reader or journal article etc. A cooperation with a practice institution is also possible. The content as well as the result of the project is supposed to consist of a report in the form of a project study. The contents of the module are related to the module o6-V-ProjPPA.</p>

<p>The students know and are able to apply approaches to scientific questions (professional and methodological competence); they have advanced problem-specific knowledge of pedagogical questions and psychological perspectives regarding behavioural disorders (professional competence); they know possibilities of theoretical and empirical data research (methodological competence); they are able to review complex problems in group work whilst sticking to a self-developed work plan in a target-oriented manner (social competence); they independently execute a complex task over a longer period of time with a high level of self-learning (self-competence).</p>
