<p>This module equips students with advanced business-specific communication skills in the target language. These will allow them to communicate appropriately, in both written and oral form, at university and in business settings.</p>		
Intended learning outcomes		
<p>Students gain sound business-specific communication skills (written and oral) in the target language. They develop advanced general and subject-specific language skills that will allow them to communicate about selected topics in corresponding situations, using language flexibly. Students are proficient in business terminology and are able to communicate effectively about topics such as new business formation and legal forms, human resources, finances (balance sheets, income statements), purchasing and distribution, banking, payment transactions, marketing, and import/export. Upon successful completion of the UNicert(R) Level III course, students will have developed business-specific communication skills in the target language that are equivalent to level "C1 -- Effective Operational Proficiency" of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages and will be issued a UNicert(R) Level III certificate.</p>

The individual grades for each course will be weighted according to the number of weekly contact hours of the respective course. UNicert (R) exam (weighted 80%): written and oral examination with 4 components (reading comprehension, listening comprehension, writing, oral communication skills), assessment components each weighted 1:1</p>
