Wissenschaftliche und künstlerische Befähigung

They will acquire the ability to classify the results of their independent analysis in a bigger literary or discourse-historical context as well as the ability to deal independently with basic and current issues of research of the Middle Ages and the Early Modern Age and to present these issues independently (research works, presentations and other methods, seminar papers and other textualisation and presentation types). They are familiar with methods of the self-organisation and time management and are able to compile individual articles for research under tutelage.
