Wissenschaftliche Befähigung

Darüber hinaus sind sie in der Lage, vergleichbare Problemstellungen in interkulturellen, globalen oder entwicklungspolitischen Zusammenhängen zu erkennen und differenziert zu reflektieren.
- Absolvent/innen sind in der Lage, komplexe Sachverhalte adressatengerecht aufzubereiten und in der jeweiligen erlernten Fremdsprache präzise und situationsangemessen zu kommunizieren.
- Absolvent/innen sind in der Lage, konstruktiv und zielorientiert in interdisziplinären und kulturell vielfältigen Teams zu arbeiten. Sie können unterschiedliche Perspektiven und Meinungen produktiv in gemeinsame Arbeitsprozesse einbringen und verfügen über die Kompetenz, mögliche Konflikte analytisch zu erfassen und lösungsorientiert zu bearbeiten.




