#### Wissenschaftliche oder künstlerische Befähigung

- Die Studierenden verfügen über vertiefte Kenntnisse hinsichtlich der Struktur des Faches sowie der Bedeutung des Bildungsbegriffes. Sie können pädagogische Sachverhalte analysieren.
