Wissenschaftliche oder künstlerische Befähigung

- Die Studierenden verfügen über Grundkenntnisse und Orientierungswissen hinsichtlich der Struktur des Faches sowie der Bedeutung des Erziehungs- und Bildungsbegriffes. Sie können pädagogische Sachverhalte interpretieren und sind in der Lage, diese zu referieren

- Die Studierenden haben Einsichten in zentrale bildungswissenschaftliche Handlungstheorien und Praxiskonzepte zur Erziehung und Bildung in verschiedenen pädagogischen Handlungsfeldern gewonnen. Sie kennen den aktuellen Stand gängiger Theorien des Lehrens und Lernens und können diese auch methodisch analysieren.
- Die Absolvent/innen wissen um wesentliche Fragen pädagogischer Aufgabenfelder und ihrer Geschichte in Theorie und Praxis.
