#### Wissenschaftliche Befähigung

- Die Studierenden besitzen grundlegende Kenntnisse über die Geschichte philosophischer Begriffe, Argumente und Theorien sowie über forschungsrelevante Fragestellungen in Systematik und Geschichte der Philosophie. Sie haben einen Überblick über die Systematik und Disziplinen der Philosophie und über die Philosophiegeschichte erworben.
- Die Studierenden haben einen Einblick in den Zusammenhang zwischen systematischer und historischer Perspektive in der Philosophie und können Wortbedeutungen und Sinnzusammenhänge in übergeordnete Wissenszusammenhänge einordnen.
- Sie verstehen das Verhältnis zwischen Philosophie und Einzelwissenschaften und wissen um die Leistung und Grenzen verschiedener Wissenschaftsgebiete.

- Die Studierende können verschiedene philosophische Texte und Sachverhalte analysieren. Sie besitzen vertiefte Kenntnisse über den Aufbau und die Merkmale philosophischer Textarten und der darin verwendeten Argumentationsmittel.
- Dementsprechend können sie philosophische Themenstellungen unter verschiedenen Zielsetzungen bearbeiten und selbständig darstellen.
