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# **Content and Objectives of the Programme**

The course specification for the Bachelor programme in Political and Social Studies provides for an interdisciplinary and multifunctional course in Social Sciences combining fundamental qualifications in scientific research with further competences in analysis and special methods. Students acquire a basic knowledge of Political Theory and Political Philosophy, Comparative Politics and Governance, International Relations, Social Theory, Social Stratification and other specific subfields of Sociology. Further competences include methodological knowledge (statistical literacy) and basic skills of empirical social research, data collection and data analysis in the Social Sciences.

The course objective of the Bachelor programme in Political and Social Studies is to enable students to be successful in meeting political, social and in particular career-orientated challenges. Due to optional courses students may focus in part either on Political Science or on Sociology.



Introduction into the calculation of statistics using statistical software like SPSS, SAS, R, or STATA: Data management and data transformations; univariate statistics: measures of central tendency, dispersion and shape; confidence intervals; bivariate statistics: contingency tables and means of subsamples; correlation coefficients, Chi<sup>2</sup>-test, t-test, and analysis of variance; classical test theory.
