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Content and Objectives of the Programme

The goal of the course of studies in ‘Modern Chinese’ is to acquaint students with the modern Chinese language as well as with important areas of modern Chinese Studies and its methods. Students may choose between a language and content track of the program. The language track includes a fully integrated stay abroad (five months) at the European Chinese Language Programme (ECLC) at Peking University in the fourth term (‘Chinese Language Enhancement Abroad’). The content track instead offers a broader base of facultative thematic modules. Within the content courses thematic modules may be chosen from such areas of China Studies as society, culture, economics, or (contemporary) history. The program qualifies students to independently access sources in modern Chinese language. The language track furthermore qualifies students for a consolidated usage of basic spoken Chinese. Thematic courses allow for a deepened understanding of the fundamentals of contemporary China in the chosen fields and qualify for systematic grasp of contemporary phenomena in the areas of societal, cultural, medial, and economic China.

Students have also been acquainted with continuous learning and qualification and are trained to develop solutions for given problems within a specific methodological context. A successful graduation furthermore requires a high degree of commitment and own initiative. Students also can avail of Chinese language competences that in the language track also include personal experience in China and intercultural competences.

The occupational field is defined by the combination of major and minor students have taken. The minor ‘Modern Chinese’ qualifies for a usage of Chinese language sources and a general competence regarding topics of Chinese studies. These may be put to use in all vocational fields that require China competence.
