Ausbildungsziele

Ziel der Ausbildung in den BA-Studiengängen Altorientalistik ist die Vermittlung von Kenntnissen der wichtigsten Teilgebiete sowie der Methoden der Altorientalistik in ihrer gesamten Vielfalt. Die Studierenden erarbeiten sich dadurch das Grundwissen, das für ein konsekutives MA-Studium im Fach Altorientalistik erforderlich ist, und erwerben überfachliche Kompetenzen, die sie für ein an ein geisteswissenschaftliches BA-Studium anschließendes Studium außerhalb der Altorientalistik oder einen Berufseinstieg benötigen.

Durch die BA-Abschlussarbeit zeigen die Studierenden, dass sie in einem thematisch und zeitlich begrenzten Rahmen in der Lage sind, eine Fragestellung aus dem Bereich der Altorientalistik nach den erlernten wissenschaftlichen Methoden unter Anleitung weitgehend selbstständig zu bearbeiten.

Auf den Zielen der BA-Studiengänge konsekutiv aufbauend sind die Ziele der Ausbildung in den MA-Studiengängen eine vertiefte Beschäftigung mit ausgewählten Themen der altorientalischen Sprachen und Kulturen, die Befähigung eigenständig Forschungsprobleme und -desiderate zu erkennen und Lösungen auf Basis eines fundierten Überblicks über die altorientalischen Kulturen zu erarbeiten sowie die für ein Promotionsstudium erforderliche Forschungserfahrung im Rahmen der MA-Abschlussarbeit zu gewinnen.

Berufsfelder

Das primäre Berufsfeld, auf das die Studiengänge zielen, ist die altorientalistische Tätigkeit in Forschungseinrichtungen (Universitäten, Akademien), in der Denkmalpflege, in Archiven, Sammlungen und im Museumswesen im In- und Ausland. Darüber hinaus werden aber auch Kompetenzen für Tätigkeiten außerhalb der wissenschaftlichen Berufsfelder vermittelt. Das Lehrangebot fördert

- Kommunikations- und Kritikfähigkeit,
- interdisziplinäres Denken,
- Diskussionsbereitschaft und -befähigung, auch beim Arbeiten im Team,
- Bereitschaft und Befähigung zum selbstständigen und selbstverantwortlichen Lernen und Arbeiten,
- Befähigung, die Bearbeitung von zur Aufgabe gestellten Thematiken stofflich, zeitlich und didaktisch zu strukturieren und Zusammenhänge zu erkennen,
- gute Fremdsprachenkenntnisse, nicht nur alter Sprachen,
- Recherchefähigkeiten.

Auf diese Weise wird dem Bedarf der Studierenden nach einer praxisnahen, auch anwendungsorientierten und damit berufsqualifizierenden Hochschulausbildung Rechnung getragen.

Fachliche Kompetenzen

Die Altorientalistik erfordert im fachlichen Bereich philologische, archäologische, kulturwissenschaftliche und historische Kompetenzen. Die Würzburger BA-Studiengänge Altorientalistik sind philologisch-kulturgeschichtlich ausgerichtet und werden ab dem WS 2022-23 ergänzt werden durch neu eingerichtete BA-Studiengänge Vorderasiatische Archäologie mit archäologisch-kulturgeschichtlicher Ausrichtung. Die Ausbildung im BA Altorientalistik hat das Ziel, die Studierenden mit den wichtigsten räumlichen und sprachlichen Teilgebieten der Altorientalistik vertraut zu machen, die Methoden philologischen Arbeitens zu lehren, sowie einen fundierten Überblick über die Kulturen des historischen östlichen Mittelmeerraums und Westasiens zu geben. Ein Schwerpunkt des Studiums der Altorientalistik liegt – im Hauptfach ausgeprägter als im Nebenfach – auf dem Erlernen der Sprachen und Schriften der altorientalischen Kulturen.

Dabei wird Wert daraufgelegt, dass

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- die Studierenden sich solide Kenntnisse über die altorientalischen Sprachen und Kulturen aneignen,
- sie in die Lage versetzt werden, altorientalische Texte im historischen Kontext vom vierten bis zum ersten vorchristlichen Jahrtausend zu erfassen, zu interpretieren und kritisch zu bewerten,
- Textquellen im funktionalen und sozialen Kontext auch unter historisch-landeskundlichen Aspekten betrachtet werden,
- die Studierenden altorientalische Denk- und Ausdrucksweisen in ihrer Metaphorik und Explizität bzw. Implizität kennenlernen, um eine Textquelle auch über die bloße Formanalyse hinaus im Sinne der Pragmatik zu verstehen,
- sie relevante altorientalische Quellentexte verschiedener Schwierigkeitsgrade im Rahmen des Curriculums im Original selbstständig übersetzen und verstehen können,
- sie in die Lage versetzt werden, handlungssicher die Methoden der altorientalischen Praxis und Feldforschung anzuwenden und umzusetzen,
- sie wichtige Kompetenzen in Nachbar- und Hilfswissenschaften erwerben, wie Archäologie, Museologie und Editions- und Ausstellungswesen,
- sie interkulturelle Kompetenzen und Verständnis für den Raum Westasien in seiner kulturhistorischen Dimension entwickeln.

Sowohl für die Beschäftigung mit altorientalischen Quellen aber auch anderen Aspekten der antiken Kulturen gilt, dass die Studierenden

• selbstständig wissenschaftlich arbeiten,

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- sich selbstständig mit sprachwissenschaftlichen und kulturhistorischen Fragestellungen beschäftigen
- sich kritisch mit aktuellen Fragen der Forschung auseinandersetzen,
- sie ihre Untersuchungsergebnisse schriftlich stilsicher und korrekt dokumentieren,
- mit Textverarbeitung umgehen, Texte edieren, Datenbanken anlegen, Daten archivieren, Daten verwalten und Daten sichern können,
- sie angemessene (digitale) Präsentationstechniken verinnerlicht haben und umsetzen können.

Die sprachliche Komponente auch für Studierende im Nebenfach eröffnet bei entsprechender Qualifikation die Möglichkeit eines konsekutiven MA-Studiums Altorientalische Sprachen und Kulturen.

Überfachliche Kompetenzen und Schlüsselqualifikationen

Die Entwicklung der überfachlichen Kompetenzen orientiert sich an den Zielvorgaben des Bologna-Prozesses. Eine hervorgehobene Rolle kommt hierbei der Informationskompetenz zu, also der Voraussetzung für die selbstorganisierte Aneignung von Wissen und damit des lebenslangen Lernens. Zur Realisierung des Studienziels "Beschäftigungsfähigkeit" wird der Vermittlung von Schlüsselkompetenzen ein hoher Stellenwert beigemessen.

Schlüsselqualifikationen werden überwiegend bereits im Fachstudium erworben, indem neben den fachlich-inhaltlichen Kompetenzen den Studierenden in den Lehrveranstaltungen kognitive Kompetenzen vermittelt werden, wie z. B. konzeptuelles Denken, Transferfähigkeit und Problemlösungsfähigkeit. Des Weiteren sind Persönlichkeitsmerkmale wie Selbstständigkeit, Kreativität, Verantwortungsbereitschaft, Leistungsbereitschaft wichtige Grundlagen für beruflichen Erfolg. Über diese fachlichen, kognitiven und persönlichen Kompetenzen hinaus sind weitere Kompetenzen für ein erfolgreiches Berufsleben von Bedeutung. Dazu zählen u. a. soziale Kompetenzen wie Konfliktmanagement und Kritikfähigkeit, Teamfähigkeit, Einfühlungsvermögen, Durchsetzungsvermögen sowie weitere Führungsqualitäten. Die Universität Würzburg hat dieser Entwicklung Rechnung getragen, indem sie für die Bachelor-Hauptfachstudiengänge in ihren unterschiedlichen Ausprägungen anteilig Bereiche ausgewiesen hat, die für den Erwerb von Schlüsselqualifikationen reserviert sind.

He/she will be able to create reasonable genitive constructions from given nouns and to translate these, to combine given substantives with pronominal suffixes and to translate these, to render verbal forms given in transliteration with a bound transcription, to analyse and to translate these forms, to name the phonetic values of simple cuneiform signs, to transliterate, transcribe and translate simple practice sentences. The student will learn to use the most important resources (grammars, dictionaries, text editions).
