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## Content and Objectives of the Programme

The subject of art education is offered by the Faculty of Human Sciences at JMU as part of a fundamentally oriented degree program consisting of two equivalent major subjects. If the final thesis is in art education, the degree of "Bachelor of Arts" (B. A.) is acquired.

The aim of the course is to provide students with scientifically sound knowledge of art education as well as skills that are important in the areas of art education.
