### **Learning Outcomes**

#### Grundverständnis des Faches und seiner Perspektiven

Das Studienfach Europäische Ethnologie/Empirische Kulturwissenschaft (= EE/EKW) vermittelt Kompetenzen zur Analyse und Interpretation kultureller, vornehmlich alltäglicher Phänomene vornehmlich – aber nicht ausschließlich – europäischer Gesellschaften in Vergangenheit und Gegenwart.

EE/EKW versteht sich als empirische Kulturwissenschaft, die alltags- und populärkulturelle Phänomene untersucht. Der Begriff Kultur wird dabei nicht als statisches, abgeschlossenes System von (hochkulturellen) Traditionen und Werten verstanden, sondern als dynamischer Prozess gesellschaftlicher Aushandlung: Das Fach befasst sich mit kulturellen Phänomenen, die v. a. europäische Gesellschaften kennzeichnen, und analysiert diese mithilfe historischer, gegenwartsbezogener, vergleichender und reflexiver Perspektiven.

Im Bachelor-Hauptfach (75 ECTS) erweitern die Studierenden ihre methodischen und theoretischen Kompetenzen zur eigenständigen Analyse kultureller, religiöser, geschlechtsspezifischer und populärkultureller Ausdrucksformen. Die praktische Anwendung ethnografischer Methoden steht dabei im Zentrum, ebenso wie die Entwicklung argumentativer Fähigkeiten und die Fähigkeit, eigene Standpunkte differenziert zu kommunizieren. Die Absolvent\*innen sind qualifiziert für anspruchsvollere Tätigkeiten in Bereichen wie Kulturmanagement, Museen, Journalismus sowie Bildungs- und Beratungsinstitutionen und besitzen darüber hinaus die Voraussetzungen zur Aufnahme eines Masterstudiums.

Ethnography of Everyday Cultures addresses selected topics of human everyday cultures and spheres of life and their ethnographic and cultural analytical research. In a multi-day excursion in a specific field of research, students address questions and collect empirical data. This course allows exercises in research topics, enables students to address and process methodical alternatives and to evaluate and interpret field research and the collected data.
