Object of both courses will be the interdisciplinarity of the French teaching methodology, the presentation and criticism of theories concerning the language acquisition, the dealing with classical methods of the Foreign Language Teaching, teaching and learning objectives of the French course - taking into account the communicative skills of the students -, the complexion of factors regarding the teaching process, particularities of teaching and the teaching of second, third or fourth scholastic foreign languages, the general conditions of institutional contexts, the role of course books as well as issues of the performance assessment.

They are able to display their knowledge on specific examples during their teaching lessons and to present there their ideas and discuss didactic issues.
