Content and Objectives of the Programme

The certificate program Synopsis is offered under the responsibility of the president of JMU as further education study program according to article 78 paragraph 1, sentence 2, no. 2, letter b) BayHIG.

The aim of the certificate program is to provide insights into different scientific cultures and the fundamentals of interdisciplinary scientific work before choosing an undergraduate degree program. This prepares students for subsequent specialized studies while also enriching them with cross-sectional or meta-competence. Furthermore, the connections between an interdisciplinary understanding of science and social issues are explored and tested in theory and practice.

Based on the study programme a certificate for the certificate programme Synopsis will be issued after all required module achievements have been completed in accordance with this FSB.
