Content and Objectives of the Programme

The certificate program Professional Skills (in the following PSZ) is offered by the Career Centre (Department 2.5 of Department 2: Student Service Center) as supplementary course program according to article 78 paragraph 5, sentence 1, no. 2 BayHIG and is aimed at students at JMU.

The goal of the certificate program is to prepare students for the global job market of the future and, even during their studies, to sensitize them to careers and working contexts that sometimes don't yet exist or are difficult to plan and predict. Professional skills enable them to independently plan and make the necessary adjustments. Unpredictable demands in the world of work require competencies that degree programs alone (may not) provide. This requires a high degree of initiative, which is developed and sharpened through the (additional) acquisition of cross-disciplinary skills.

Upon completion of the course of study, a certificate for the PSZ certificate program will be issued after all required module achievements have been met in accordance with this FSB.
