Grundverständnis des Faches und seiner Perspektiven

Das Studienfach Europäische Ethnologie/Empirische Kulturwissenschaft (= EE/EKW) vermittelt Kompetenzen zur Analyse und Interpretation kultureller, vornehmlich alltäglicher Phänomene vornehmlich – aber nicht ausschließlich – europäischer Gesellschaften in Vergangenheit und Gegenwart.

EE/EKW versteht sich als empirische Kulturwissenschaft, die alltags- und populärkulturelle Phänomene untersucht. Der Begriff Kultur wird dabei nicht als statisches, abgeschlossenes System von (hochkulturellen) Traditionen und Werten verstanden, sondern als dynamischer Prozess gesellschaftlicher Aushandlung: Das Fach befasst sich mit kulturellen Phänomenen, die v. a. europäische Gesellschaften kennzeichnen, und analysiert diese mithilfe historischer, gegenwartsbezogener, vergleichender und reflexiver Perspektiven.

Der Master-Nebenfachstudiengang Europäische Ethnologie/Empirische Kulturwissenschaft (45 ECTS) vermittelt vertiefte methodische und theoretische Kenntnisse des Faches. Die Studierenden erwerben die Fähigkeit, kulturelle Phänomene analytisch zu erfassen und eigenständig kleinere Forschungsprojekte durchzuführen oder an größeren Projekten unterstützend mitzuwirken. Besonderer Wert wird auf die Befähigung zur methodisch fundierten Mitarbeit in interdisziplinären Forschungskontexten, die Reflexion gesellschaftlicher Fragestellungen sowie auf die Weiterentwicklung personaler Kompetenzen gelegt. Der Abschluss qualifiziert für Tätigkeiten in wissenschaftsnahen Berufsfeldern, Kulturinstitutionen sowie für die Mitarbeit in Forschungsprojekten und interdisziplinären Teams.
