Students of the Master programme History of Medieval and Modern Art (120 ECTS) acquire researchoriented competence in terms of art historical analysis in the field of style criticism and image science, in the scientific and cultural history and acquire a deeper insight into the discourse of contemporary art history -related issues. They are enabled through practical source research in art-historical context for independent methodical and scientific development of an art-historical problem.
