Berufsziele

Im viersemestrigen Masterstudiengang Psychologie (akademischer Grad: "Master of Science, M.Sc.") werden **die** im Bachelorstudiengang Psychologie (B.Sc. Psychologie) erworbenen grundlegenden psychologischen Fähigkeiten und Kenntnisse vertieft und erweitert. Die Studierenden erlangen die Fähigkeit, eigenständig nach wissenschaftlichen Methoden zu arbeiten, und werden auf die Berufspraxis als Psychologin/Psychologe vorbereitet. Das Studium versieht die Studierenden mit einer Berufsfeldqualifikation für ein breites Spektrum an Handlungsfeldern in fachlichen Institutionen und in der Privatwirtschaft, beispielsweise in den Bereichen Forschung, Gesundheit, Erziehung und Bildung, Sozialwesen, Arbeitswelt und Kultur. Die Berufsfelder beziehen sich unter anderem auf

- die Lehre an Schulen, Hochschulen und Universitäten
- die Forschung in universitären und außeruniversitären Forschungseinrichtungen
- Arbeits- und Betriebsorganisation, Unternehmensentwicklung und Personalbereich
- Forensik, Justizvollzug und Gerichtswesen, z. B. Gutachtenerstellung
- Beratungs- und Leitungsfunktion in Beratungsstellen im Erziehungs- und Gesundheitsbereich
- Tätigkeiten in der Weiterbildung
- Tätigkeiten in der Bildungsevaluation
- Schulpsychologie (außerhalb Bayerns)
- Verkehrspsychologie
- Tätigkeit im öffentlichen Dienst

Nach aktueller Lage des Arbeitsmarktes sind die Einstellungsaussichten von Absolventinnen und Absolventen der Psychologie sehr gut. Die Arbeitslosigkeit liegt mit 2.3% bezogen auf das Jahr 2018 nach Angaben der Bundesagentur für Arbeit deutlich unter der allgemeinen Arbeitslosenquote und auch unterhalb der Arbeitslosenquote von Akademikerinnen und Akademikern.

Die interdisziplinär angelegte Vorlesung bietet eine Einführung in das Gebiet der forensischen Psychiatrie. Aus psychiatrischer, juristischer, psychologischer und entwicklungsdynamischer Perspektive werden theoretische Grundkenntnisse vermittelt und anhand von präsentierten Einzelfällen, die aktuell zur Begutachtung anstehen bzw. klinisch besonders interessant sind, beispielhaft vertieft. Die Veranstaltungen sollen einerseits Grundlagen über Erscheinungsbilder, Entwicklung und Behandlung von psychischen Störungen wie Schizophrenie, Suchterkrankungen, Sexualstörungen, Persönlichkeitsstörungen etc. vermitteln, andererseits sollen relevante rechtliche Problemfelder im Kontext von psychischen Erkrankungen aufgezeigt werden. Betreuungs- und sozialrechtliche Aspekte werden daher ebenso erörtert wie verschiedene Formen der Delinquenz (z.B.: Eigentumsdelikte, Tötungs- und Sexualdelikte) sowie Fragen der Prognoseerstellung und Glaubhaftigkeit, des Opferschutzes und der Kriminalprävention bei Jugendlichen und Erwachsenen.

Main topics are cognitive, socio-emotional and physical development across the lifespan, educational and developmental processes in the family context and in pedagogical institutions as well as practical work in the field such as counseling and pedagogical-psychological interventions (e.g., psychological learning therapy), psychology of digital media, learning with media, media literacy, media effects, and media socialization. Within this module, topics can vary per semester.

Intended learning outcomes

The students deepen their competencies gained in the bachelor's program. They gain in-depth theoretical expertise in current, practice- and research-related subject areas of Educational Psychology, Developmental Psychology, Media Psychology and their intersections. The module prepares the students for various occupational fields, such as research activities in Educational Psychology, Developmental Psychology or Media Psychology, Psychological Diagnostics, School Psychology, Psychological Counseling in Education, Psychological Learning Therapy, Educational Evaluation and Media Design and Analysis in the professional fields of Media Psychology (e.g. Media Authorities and the Media Industry).
