Wissenschaftliche oder künstlerische Befähigung

- Die Studierenden haben ein vertieftes Verständnis zu Grundfragen- und Grundproblemen der Erziehungs- und Bildungstheorie erlangt. Sie sind in der Lage, bildungswissenschaftliche Fragestellungen methodisch-reflexiv einzuordnen und zu erörtern. Zudem wissen sie sowohl um historische Entwicklungen als auch um aktuelle Forschungsfragen der Bildungswissenschaft.
- Studierende sind dazu in die Lage versetzt, eigenständig und nach wissenschaftlich-systematischen Kriterien empirische Studien im Bereich der Bildungsforschung erfolgreich durchzuführen, nach neuesten Methoden auszuwerten und Befunde auf theoretische Konzepte zurückzu beziehen.

- Die Studierenden wissen um die Bedeutung der Ethik für die Erziehungs- und Bildungswissenschaft. Darüber hinaus können die Studierenden die zentralen Grundfragen- und -probleme ethischen Handelns im Zusammenhang mit bildungswissenschaftlichen Handlungs- und Reflexionsfeldern bewerten.

Wahlpflichtbereich 1: Kulturpädagogik

- Sie wissen nicht nur um wesentliche Fragen bildungswissenschaftlicher Aufgaben- und Reflexionsfelder, sondern sind darüber hinaus in die Lage versetzt, diese professionstheoretischen Fragen und Diskurse unter der perspektivischen Betrachtung von Kulturalität und Sozialität zu analysieren und zu reflektieren.
- Die Studierenden können vor dem Hintergrund pädagogischer Praxis- und Arbeitsfelder im kulturellen Bereich verschiedene Kulturtheorien sowie bildungswissenschaftliche Fragestellungen zu Ästhetik und Kulturtechnologien bewerten und reflektieren.

- Die Studierenden haben ein vertieftes Verständnis zu zentralen Fragen und Problemstellungen des Bildungsmanagements als spezifisches Aufgabenfeld und wissen um ihre Geschichte in Theorie und Praxis. Sie haben Wissen im Kontext professioneller Handlungsformen beruflich-betrieblicher Weiterbildung erlangt. Sie sind dazu in die Lage versetzt, vor dem Hintergrund verschiedene Handlungsfelder der Erwachsenen- und Weiterbildung professionstheoretische Fragen und Problemstellungen zu reflektieren.
