Course of Studies - Contents and Objectives

The German-speaking Master »Political and Socials Sciences« is a consecutive and researchoriented study course for students with knowledge of Political Science and Sociology. It enables the students to do their research independently and autonomously. The study course includes Comparative Politics, European Studies and International Relations, Political Theory as well as General and Special Sociology. Moreover, it depends the methodological knowledge and the skills of Empirical Social Research. The students enhance their profiles through individual priorisation of their research, work-related internships, studies abroad and additional qualifications.
